① Busan Citizen Park

Camp Hialeah, a piece of foreign land in Korea for 100 years, has been transformed into an enormous urban garden under the five themes of memory, culture, pleasure, nature, and participation. It is equipped with a wide range of facilities to provide a unique and joyful experience, including Hialeah Lawn Plaza which measures six times the size of soccerfield, FiveWalking Trails, a Metasequoia Trail, a Park Museum, a Tunnel Fountain, a Maze Garden and a Culture and Art Village.

② Bokcheon Museum

Displaying 200 tombs and 12,000 relics discovered in Historic Site No. 273 Bokcheondong Ancient Tombs, this museum allows visitors to explore Gaya which is the ancient kingdom that existed in Busan region. It offers a glimpse of the culture of Gaya which still remains a mysterious kingdom today as well as the origin of the ancient culture of Japan.

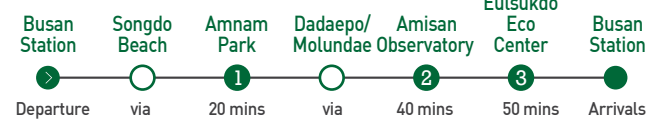


③ Beomeosa

Founded by a Royal Preceptor Uisang in the 18th year (678AD) of King Mummu's reign during Silla dynasty, this Huayan temple is one of the 3 main Buddhist temples of Yeongnam along with Haeinsa Temple and Tongdosa Temple. Situated in the foot of Geumjeongsan Mountain, where legend says golden fish came down from the sky on multi-colored clouds to play in the Geumsaem Spring, the name "Beomeosa" is a reference to "fish from the sky." It houses regional cultural heritages such as Daeungjeon Hall (Treasure No. 434), 3-story Stone Pagoda (Treasure No. 250), flagpole supports, Iljumun Gate, stone lanterns, and 3-story stone pagodas.

Enjoy a forest walk while looking down at the sea at this downtown park where breathtaking views of dense oceanic forests, uniquely shaped rock cliffs, and the blue ocean are blended in the background. It is also the site of several Neolithic relics including comb-patterned pottery and shell mounds. Situated nearby are Songdo Beach, Dudo Park, Songnim Park.

Eulsukdo Eco Center ③

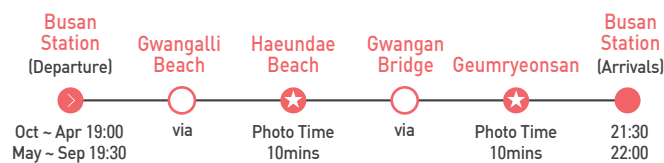


Eulsukdo Eco Center is dedicated to the conservation and management of Eulsukdo Migratory Bird Park which is the world class bird sanctuary and provides spaces for the exhibition of ecology and educational experiences. The center offers a variety of exhibits and images for viewing including models of migratory birds, and the movement of migratory birds and reed fields can be observed through telescopes. Built to the winning design of an international architectural design competition, the beautiful design of the Center blends with the eco park, marsh walkway to create an exotic atmosphere.

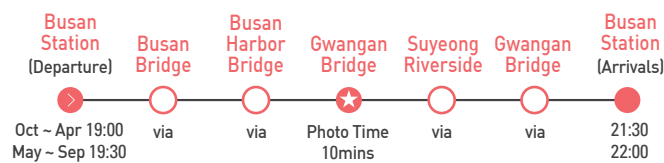

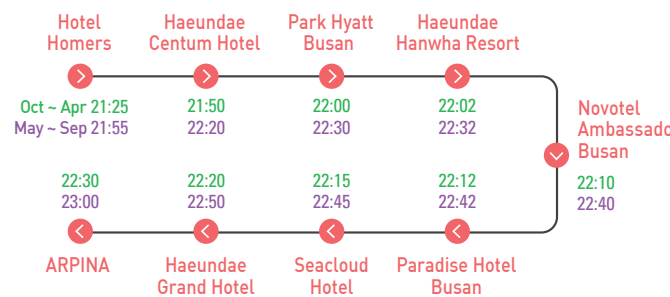

- In front of Arirang Hotel at Busan Station Square (between Exit 8 of Busan Metro and Exit 1 of Busan Railway Station)
- Hop-on hop-off service at every stop on the Loop Tour

➤ How to Buy Tickets

- Loop Tour
- A Loop tour ticket gives the holder all-day access to the 3 LINES (Redline, BlueLine, Greenline) of Loop tour.
- A Day pass for the Loop tour can be purchased from the driver at the time of boarding at each stop. (first-come-first-served)
- ※ It costs surcharge to transfer Taejongdae course(Tel. +82-51-714-3799) from the BUTl Loop Tour. (Adults:5,000won/Children:3,000won)
- ※ To buy a transfer ticket for Taejongdae Course, you should present the previously purchased Redline, BlueLine, or Greenline ticket.

Oryukdo Islets

The Oryukdo Islets have been a long beloved symbol of the sea of Busan. It is often thought that the name "Oryukdo" refers to the number of islets being five at low tide and six at high tide, but in actual fact, "Dongrae buji (Records of Dongrae Village)" published in 1740 reveals, "The islets were named so as they form six peaks when seen from the east and five when seen from the west." The Oryukdo Skywalk Observatory, built on a 35m high coastal cliff at the entrance of Haeparang-gil Road, offers an exciting view of the blue sea below a transparent floor.

Referred to as the most celebrated mountain of Busan, Mt.Hwangryeongsan is famous for its scenic driving routes, night views, and astronomical observation points. A ritual for mountain deity and signal fire event are held each year at Beacon Fire Station of Mt.Hwangryeongsan, and in spring, the mountain offers beautiful cherry blossom walkways to enjoy.

Dalmaji-gil Road

Nicknamed the "Montmartre of Busan," Dalmaji-gil Road features the "Moonland Road" ideal for gentle moonlight walks which gives rise to the saying, "enjoy sun tanning on the white sand beach of Haendae during the day, and moon tanning at night." It is home to various galleries and exotic cafes as well as top restaurants. Together with the forest and sea, leafy shade and ocean waves, the moonrise of Dalmaji-gil Road has long been considered one of the eight scenic views of Korea. In springtime, the cherry blossom walkway in full bloom creates romantic scenery.

Fisheries Science Museum · Haedong Yonggungsa

As Korea's first maritime and fisheries science museum opened in May 1997, the Fisheries Science Museum serves the purpose of introducing the development process of fisheries and maritime science technology and promoting the value of the Ocean to general citizens as well as adolescents. It consists of 14 sections each with individual themes such as Aquarium, Dokdo Island Hall, etc., and features approx. 7,000 exhibits on display with the entire museum open to public free of charge.

Built in 1376 by Naeng, a royal preceptor of King Gongmin of Goryeo Dynasty, this temple is one of the three main Buddhist pilgrimage sites of Korea. Walk past the twelve zodiac figurines along the forest walkway and down the 108 steps to discover an offshore Buddhist sanctuary opposite the sea that will grant you a magical experience as if you are entering an actual under water kingdom. Religion, tourism culture, and spiritual relaxation come together at this place where, in addition to the breathtaking scenery, a belief that anyone who prays with all their heart will definitely have a wish fulfilled brings endless streams of Buddhist believers and tourists.

Featuring an extensive range of road shops, this fashion street offers a diverse shopping experience from premium international brands to no-brand apparel. Busan Christmas Tree Festival is held in early December each year with beautiful LED lamps embroidering the skies of Gwangbokro where various street performances are held.

Situated near UN Memorial Cemetery, this neighborhood park is a beloved relaxation venue for Busan citizens. It features Peace Plaza and Revival Plaza as well as an eco pond, grass fields, walkways, jogging courses, ground fountains, sculptures, and rest areas and is home to 30,000 trees including pine and camellia as well as 30,000 flowering plants. The ground fountains are particularly popular for water games in the summer.

Attractions: UN Memorial Cemetery, Sculpture Park, Busan Museum
